WARNING:

- The TwistLok GraviFeed syringe is not intended for intravascular or intravenous use.
- This device has the potential to misconnect with small bore connectors of other healthcare applications.

CAUTIONS:

- Contents are sterile in an unopened, undamaged package. Do not use this device if opened or damaged.
- Do not re-sterilize.
- The patient's age, condition, and ability to feed orally will determine the method of feeding.

INDICATIONS FOR USE:

• The TwistLok GraviFeed syringe is intended to be attached to a nasogastric feeding tube and/or extension set for introduction of enteral fluids and/or oral medication. The TwistLok GraviFeed syringe is disposable and single use only.

RECOMMENDED PROCEDURE:

- Use clean technique.
- Ensure this device is only connected to an enteral port and not to an I.V. set.
- Pour breast milk or formula into the TwistLok GraviFeed syringe and ensure the lid is securely closed.
- Place a thumb over the hole on the top of the lid and remove the non-vented cap.
- Attach TwistLok male connector to TwistLok female connector of feeding tube or extension set. Check to ensure the syringe connector is fully engaged to the feeding tube or extension set.

SYRINGE REMOVAL:

• Remove the syringe and discard per hospital protocol.

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
